With all mowers, mower attachments and other rotary cutting devices, there is a chance of objects *being shot out at high speeds*. These objects could cause serious injury or death to the operator or bystanders. Thoroughly inspect the area where the equipment is to be used. Clear it of objects such as rocks, toys, wire, bones, sticks, etcetera. Always wear eye, dust, foot, leg and hand protection whenever operating this unit. Keep children, animals and others at least 100 feet away at all times.

Never operate power equipment of any kind if you are tired or if you are under the influence of alcohol, drugs, medication, or any substance that could affect your ability or judgment. Be alert! If you get tired while operating this equipment, take a break. Tiredness may result in loss of control.

Provide adequate ventilation when operating this equipment. Internal combustion engines consume oxygen and give off deadly carbon monoxide gas.

Do not tape down or otherwise by-pass any safety devices! Always operate this equipment from the designated operator's position.

Use extreme caution: The mower blade is very sharp! Keep your hands and feet clear of the blade at all times.


IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW

- 1. Be familiar with the area you are going to cut weeds. Cut only in daylight.
- **2.** Before cutting weeds make sure the area is clear of solid objects & debris that could be thrown or damage the machine.
- **3.** Do not cut when raining or when weeds are wet.
- **4.** Do not operate the weed mower without deflectors or shields in place.
- **5.** Before beginning work, check weed mower to make sure no damage has occurred in transit to controls or safety devices.

6. ALWAYS WEAR PROTECTIVE EYE DEVICES INCLUDING A FACE SHIELD.

- **7.** Do not allow children to operate weed mower. Keep others, especially children & pets, away from work area. Do not operate in proximity of windows or other breakable items.
- **8.** Do not wear loose fitting clothes that could get caught. Wear long sleeve shirts, long pants & boots when operating a weed mower.
- **9.** Stop the engine & set the parking brake whenever you leave the mower.
